Legislative: MSgt (Ret) Terry Shannon reported on H.R. 1203 which would amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to allow Federal civilian and military retirees to pay health insurance premiums on a pretax basis and to allow a deduction for TRICARE supplemental premiums. Another Bill (HR 816) would prohibit DoD from increasing TRICARE fees, specifying that the authority to increase TRICARE fees exists only in Congress. Chief Moses and others reported that the Lions Gate has raised fees for meeting space to the extent that the organizations have had to find other locations.
