6. Chairman's Comments:

**Regular:**

- \$216.10 spent on awards packages and ribbons for ROTC presentations. Valley, Casa Roble, and Highlands High will have award ceremonies in May.
  - 2005 Operations Chapter report was filed with headquarters.
  - 1442 man hours were logged last year for volunteer duties by the regular chapter. Thanks to all who helped out.
- \$2,051.18 was donated; this does not include the \$800 in towels or \$1,096.00 donated by the Auxiliary.

9. Legislative:
  - There are proposals for co-pays to double for the Military Health Care System (Tri-Care Prime). This would also call for an enrollment fee for the first time.

  - c. Air Museum support. This is an ongoing commitment. We are committed to two volunteers every third Saturday from 12:00 – 4:00. A schedule for 2006 was passed around. (OPEN)
  - d. Mather Air Show, 18 -19 Mar 06. Jim sent an email around. We will not be able to volunteer as an organization but Tom Wentz arranged so we could volunteer individually, only one volunteer responded, so we will not work this year. (CLOSED)
11. New Business:
  - a. Weiner/Pizza sale – 11 Mar 06. To be held by the commissary case lot sale. (OPEN)
  - b. T-Shirt purchase – Purchased 112 shirts @ 1.04 ea. Approved by the executive committee on short notice when the shirts became available. (CLOSED)
  - c. Cordova Community Council – Motion approved and seconded to join the Cordova Community Council, cost \$20. (CLOSED)
  - d. VFW dinner - 31 March 6 - 9 p.m. Still trying to come up with "signature" dinner. Two suggestions were BBQ ribs and pork chops. (OPEN)
