  - SMSgt (Ret) Wes Wheeler discussed Bill # H.R.42 Freedom to Display Flag on residential property which states that an association may not adopt or enforce any policy that would restrict or prevent an association member from displaying the U.S. flag.
  - He also discussed ways to freeze your credit and the legislation that is being introduced (H.R. Bill #397) to reduce the states rights to allow the freezing of credit.
  - SMSgt (Ret) Wes Wheeler has created a folder with all the legislative actions being considered that he will keep updated and bring to all the meetings.
