6. **Chairman's Comments:**

Regular: CMSgt (Ret) Jim Sullivan reported that the *Vet Press* had notices detailing the Christmas Party and Breakfast with Santa. The *Grapevine Independent* in Rancho Cordova area also had the notice for the Christmas Party.

 - f. Television Donation to VA. The membership donated \$106.10 to share the cost of a television purchased by the auxiliary for the waiting area at the VA Medical Center. (CLOSED)
 - g. NCOA Banner. Chief Sullivan purchased a new banner to replace the current one. The purchase price was \$139.43. (CLOSED)
