After months of criticism about how the military accounts for the remains of fallen U.S. service members from foreign battlefields, Defense Secretary Chuck Hagel said Monday he will create a single Pentagon-level office to oversee the worldwide mission. The new office will consolidate all aspects of the mission for finding the estimated 83,000 Americans who remain missing from World War II and the wars in Korea and Vietnam. Details were given related to a Sexual Assault video available and now a mandatory requirement for active duty members.
